### **Classification**



### **Competition centre, meeting place & showers**

Jels School, Krygersvej 2, Jels, where you find the competition centre with changing facilities, showers, overnight stay and kiosk. The competition centre will open Friday from 16:00.

### **How to get there**

**Friday:** Road no. 175 between Toftlund and Skærbæk.  
Assembly area: Arrild Feriecenter.

**Saturday:** signage from road no. 11 at Vester Vedsted south of Ribe. Turn off Vester Vedstedvej and continue to the assembly area in the middle of the forest.

**Sunday:** Road no. 175 between Toftlund and Skærbæk. Signage from the crossroads at Hønning.  
Parking at assembly area: Poulkrovej approx. 300 m north of Gånsagervej.

### **Distances**

Max 500 m from parking to start.

Friday 18:00, Saturday 13:00, Sunday 10:00.

### **Start procedure**

Free start (put'n'run) in all classes.  
Friday 18:00-19:00  
Saturday 13:00-14:30  
Sunday 10:00-11:30  
H/D-10, H/D11-12 and BEG get the map 2 mins. before start.

### **Map and terrain**

Friday: **Arrild Ferieby**  
1:4000 – Revised 2021  
Various terrain in summer cottage area – combined with some woodland.

Saturday: **Sdr. Farup and V. Vedsted Bjergplantager**

1:10000 and 1:7500- revised 2021. Many details, inland dunes – not used before in the Vikingedyst. There are 8 private landowners on the map.

**Sunday: Hønning Plantage**

1:10000 and 1:7500 – revised 2021.

Many details, a large open area with inland dunes.

Mainly deciduous forest, some hills in the northern parts and assembly area in Slotsparken. This year's terrain is privately owned, and no less than 20 proprietors have given permission for use.

New virgin area south west of the old map.

### SI-cards

Rental SI-cards are handed out at the start. The rental SI-card must be returned after finishing on Sunday. In case of malfunctioning control: punch on the control description on your map.

Rental of an SI-card costs DKK 15 in addition to the entry fee for each race. There is a no-return charge of DKK 500.

### Entry fees

M/W-20 Friday DKK 80, Saturday-Sunday DKK 80/day (160).  
M/W21+ Friday DKK 100, Saturday-Sunday DKK 100/day (200).  
**It is possible to do single days, but Saturday plus Sunday count for prizes and Viking challenge trophies!**

### Accommodation

Basic accommodation is available from Friday to Sunday in or around the competition centre.

#### In classrooms

Hard surface (bring your own mattress and sleeping bag).
