### Classification



### How to get there

**Friday:** Sprint in Haderslev Center. Parking is available in public parking lots on Filosofgang east of Menu and on the old The town hall parking lot east of the disused town hall. (Parking is free in both places but a parking disc is required at Menu) NB: The parking lots are in the race area. From P go directly (south) to Gåskærgade and from there via the turn to Gravene.

Meeting place: Gravene in Haderslev max 300 meters from the proposed parking options. GPS coordinate in Google maps is 55.25148 / 9.48689

**Saturday:** Marking from the roundabout at exit 68 on the motorway north or south. Entrance via Hammelev Bygade and Christiansdalvej  
Meeting point: Meeting point at Christiansdal nature camp. Parking on field on/by Christiansdalvej.

**Sunday:** Marking from the roundabout at exit 68 on the motorway north or south from. Entrance via Hammelev Bygade and Christiansdalvej.  
Meeting point: Meeting point at Christiansdal nature camp. Parking on field on/by Christiansdalvej.

### Distances

**Friday:** Parking - event site max 300 meters - Start right at the event site.

**Saturday:** Parking max 1000 meters - to start approx. 800 m from the event site.

**Sunday:** Parking max 1000 meters - to start max. 300 m from the event site.

### Parkering

Follow the parking attendants' instructions, then it will be very easier.

<b>First start</b>	Friday 18:00, Saturday 13:00, Sunday 10:00.
<b>Start procedure</b>	<p>Free start (put'n'run) in all classes.</p> <p>Friday 18:00-19:00</p> <p>Saturday 13:00-14:30</p> <p>Sunday 10:00-11:30</p> <p>H/D-10, H/D11-12 and BEG get the map 2 mins. before start.</p>
<b>Map and terrain</b>	<p>Friday: Haderslev Centrum</p> <p>1:3,000 for classes H/D45+ other classes 1:4,000. The map was revised in 2025 by Vagn Hansen OK HTF</p> <p>Haderslev is an old market town, with many fine and exciting small passages and roads. There is a lot of traffic in the area, so you must be careful to use pedestrian crossings and consider the city's citizens. It is emphasized that you comply with the traffic law, and respect private (olive green) areas and areas with exhibition/outdoor dining (violet) and it is strictly forbidden to force hedges and other plantings that are marked as impassable (dark green). We would like to come again.</p> <p>Saturday: Pamhule Forest</p> <p>1:10:000 and 7,500 revised in 2024 by GT Maps and Lars Klogborg</p> <p>Slightly to heavily hilly mixed deciduous and coniferous forest. The forest is very varied and dense in some places. The permeability is also very varied with a well-developed trail network. Part of the forest is an untouched forest. The largest and most difficult to pass fallen trees are included on the map as green lines or small densities.</p> <p>On the course for H11-12 and D11-12 there will be a marking from post 11 to 12, where the runners are guided down a slope via a slightly steep staircase.</p> <p>H11-12, D11-12, H-10, D-10 and Beginner run in some places on mountain bike tracks. The forest is not closed for mountain bikers, but the mountain bike club is informed that there are runners in the forest.</p> <p>On the way from the competition area to the start, cross the finish line. Be considerate and give way to the runners. Runners must also be aware that they are going onto a gravel road where a car may occasionally pass.</p> <p>Sunday: Tørning Mølle Forest</p> <p>1:7:500– revised in 2025 by Keld Rasmussen</p> <p>Slightly to heavily undulating mixed deciduous and coniferous forest. Through running ability may vary but is generally good with a well-developed trail network.</p>

On the course for H10, D10 and pitch there will be a marking between posts 4 and 5 and on the course for H11-12, D11-12 there will be a marking between posts 3 and 4.

There will be a short turn in classes D60, D65, H70 and H75  
Prohibited areas marked in red must not be passed, as there are cows in the area.

Generally, the vegetation is high in Pamhule and Tørning Mølle

Marking to the start must be followed so that you do not enter the running areas
